Timi Zajc wins second World Cup ski flying in Oberstdorf

Oberstdorf, March 20th 2022: 3rd place on Saturday, 1st place on Sunday: Timi Zajc could hardly hide the more than satisfied smile behind his mask. The 21-year-old Slovenian improved from 400.0 to 407.9 points on the second day of the Oberstdorf Ski Flying World Cup. Already in the qualification round he set a mark with 205.7 points. With jumps of 211.5 and 232 meters he secured victory ahead of Poland's Piotr Zyla (401.1 points) and Saturday's World Cup winner Stefan Kraft (399.8 points). Local hero Karl Geiger from SC Oberstdorf was - as on the first ski flying day - the best German and finished ninth with 375.9 points, equal on points with Markus Eisenbichler. Severin Freund (372.4/rank 13), Constantin Schmid (339.1/rank 24) and Stephan Leyhe (335.9/rank 26) rounded off the decent team results from the German point of view. At the end of a long Olympic season the skiflyers will now travel to Planica (SLO) to collect important points for the Overall World Cup standings next weekend.
